**Re: Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy (FOIP) Request**


This office is continuing to process your request for information regarding to Human Rights complaint files and any other records relating to Ezra Levant, JMCK Western Publishing Corporation, or The Western Standard, on behalf of the Human Rights and Citizenship Commission.

I am writing to you to amend my earlier letter of February 28, 2008. In that letter, I indicated that we had received your request on February 14, 2008 and the due date for responding to the request will be March 17, 2008. Upon a review of the file, however, I note that this office did not receive your request and payment of the initial fee until February 25<sup>th</sup>. Under sections 2(2) and 10(3) of the *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Regulation*, while a request under the Act can be delivered to any office, the time limit for responding to a request does not begin until the request (and initial fee) is received in an office authorized to receive requests. As indicated in the Directory of Public Bodies on the Alberta Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy website (<http://foip.gov.ab.ca>), our office is the designated FOIP Office for the Human Rights and Citizenship Commission.

We will reply to your request, or provide you with a further update as to our progress, on or before March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2008.
